1.1.1 Name of Work:

1.1.3 QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

1.1.3.1 Eligible Applicants:

i. The tenders for this contract will be considered only from those tenderers (proprietorship firms, partnerships firms, companies, corporations) who meet requisite eligibility criteria prescribed in the sub-clauses of clause 1.1.3 of NIT.

Joint Ventures and consortiums are not allowed to participate in the tenderer.

- ii. A tenderer shall submit only one bid in the same tendering process. A tenderer who submits or participates in, more than one bid will cause all of the proposals in which the tenderer has participated to be disqualified. No tenderer can be a subcontractor while submitting a bid in the same bidding process.
- iii. Tenderers shall not have a conflict of interest. All Tenderers found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. Tenderers shall be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:
 - (a) a tenderer has been engaged by the Employer to provide consulting services for the preparation related to procurement for on implementation of the project;
 - (b) a tenderer is any associates/affiliates (inclusive of parent firms) mentioned in subparagraph (a) above; or
 - (c) a tenderer lends, or temporarily seconds its personnel to firms or organisations which are engaged in consulting services for the preparation related to procurement for on implementation of the project, if the personnel would be involved in any capacity on the same project.
- vi. The Tenderer/applicant must not have been blacklisted or debarred as on the due date of submission of bid by Government of India/ State Government / Government undertaking from participating in the tenders. The tenderer should submit an undertaking to this effect in Form of Tender. The tenderer shall also submit a "Verification Statement" to this effect as per proforma placed at Annexure 1A of ITT.

1.1.3.2 Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

- A The tenderers will be qualified only if they satisfy the criteria as given in para A-1 & A-2 below:
- **A-1 Work Experience**: The tenderers will be qualified only if they have completed work(s) during last seven years ending **31.05.2018** as given below:
 - (i) At least One "similar work" ** each of value of Rs. 3.23 crores or more.

OR

(ii) Two "similar work" ** each of value of Rs. 2.04 crores or more.

OR

- (iii) Three "similar work" ** each of value of Rs. 1.63 crores or more.
- ** "Similar work" for this contract shall be work involving installation of FIH approved Synthetic Hockey Turfs."
- A-2
- (i) The bidder should be FIH Certified Field Builder / preferred supplier and should bid in this tender directly not through their dealer/distributor/ agent/ representative. Bidder needs to fulfil all other terms and condition of the tender by themselves.
- (ii) The product / brand offered should be from FIH preferred suppliers. The certificate from preferred supplier has to be submitted with technical bids.

(iii) The bidder should have installed at least **one** FIH Certified Global Category Synthetic Hockey Turf in India.

NOTE:-

- The tenderer shall submit details of work executed by them in the Performa of **Appendix-17** for the works to be considered for qualification of works experience criteria.
- For the above, documentary proof such as completion certificates from client clearly indicating the nature/scope of work, actual completion cost and actual date of completion for such work should be submitted. The offers submitted without this documentary proof shall not be evaluated. In case the work is executed for private client, copy of work order, bill of quantities, bill wise details of payment received certified by C.A., T.D.S certificates for all payments received and copy of final/last bill paid by client shall be submitted.
- Value of successfully completed portion of any ongoing work up to 31.05.2018 will also be considered for qualification of work experience criteria.
- For completed works, value of work done shall be updated to 31.05.2018 price level assuming 5% inflation for Indian Rupees every year and 2% for foreign currency portions per year. Selling rate of exchange at the close of business of the State Bank of India on the day twenty eight days before the latest date of Tender Submittal shall be considered for calculating equivalent value in INR.
- Criteria for work experience for "installation of FIH approved Hockey Turf Pitches" shall be satisfied by a single entity.
- **B.** Financial Standing: The tenderers will be qualified only if they have minimum financial capabilities as below:
- (i) **T1 -Liquidity:** It is necessary that the firm can withstand cash flow that the contract will require until payments received from the Employer. Liquidity therefore becomes an important consideration.
 - This shall be seen from the balance sheets and/or from the banking reference. Net current assets and/or documents including banking reference, should show that the applicant has access to or has available liquid assets, lines of credit and other financial means to meet cash flow of **Rs. 0.81 Crores** for this contract, net of applicant's commitments for other Contracts. Banking reference should contain in clear terms the amount that bank will be in a position to lend for this work to the applicant. In case the Net Current Assets (as seen from the Balance Sheets) are negative, only the Banking references will be considered. Otherwise the aggregate of the Net Current Assets and submitted Banking references will be considered for working out the Liquidity.
 - The banking reference should be from a Scheduled Bank in India acceptable to LMRC and it should not be more than 3 months old as on date of submission of bids.
- (ii) **T2 Profitability:** Profit before Tax should be Positive in at least 1(one) year, out of the last three audited financial years.

- (iii) T3 Net Worth: Net Worth of tenderer during last audited financial year should be > Rs. 0.58 Crores.
- (iv) **T4 Annual Turnover**: The average annual turnover of **the company in** last three financial years should be > **Rs. 3.26 Crores**.

Notes:

- Financial data for latest last three audited financial years has to be submitted by the tenderer in **Appendix-18** along with audited balance sheets. The financial data in the prescribed format shall be certified by Chartered Accountant with his stamp and signature. In case audited balance sheet of the last financial year is not made available by the bidder, he has to submit an affidavit certifying that 'the balance sheet has actually not been audited so far'. In such a case the financial data of previous '2' audited financial years will be taken into consideration for evaluation. If audited balance sheet of any year other than the last year is not submitted, the tender will be considered as non-responsive.
- Where a work is undertaken by a group, only that portion of the contract which is undertaken by the concerned applicant/member should be indicated and the remaining done by the other members of the group be excluded. This is to be substantiated with documentary evidence.

1.1.3.3 Bid Capacity Criteria:

Bid Capacity: The tenderers will be qualified only if their available bid capacity is more than the approximate cost of work as per NIT. Available bid capacity will be calculated based on the following formula:

Available Bid Capacity = 2*A*N - B

Where,

- A = Maximum value of works executed in any one year during the last three financial years (updated to **31.05.2018** price level assuming 5% inflation for Indian Rupees every year and 2% for foreign currency portions per year).
- N = No. of years prescribed for completion of the work
- B = Value of existing commitments (as on 31.05.2017) for on-going works during period of 12 months w.e.f. 01.06.2018.

Notes:

- Financial data for latest last three financial years has to be submitted by the tenderer in **Appendix-15 of FOT** along with audited financial statements. The financial data in the prescribed format shall be certified by the Chartered Accountant with his stamp and signature in original.
- Value of existing commitments for on-going works during period of 12 months w.e.f. 01.06.2018 has to be submitted by the tenderer in Appendix-16 of FOT. These data shall be certified by the Chartered Accountant with his stamp and signature.
- In the case of a group, the above formula will be applied to each member to the extent of his proposed participation in the execution of the work. If the proposed % participation is not mentioned, then equal participation

will be assumed.

1.1.3.4 The tender submission of tenderers, who do not qualify the minimum eligibility criteria stipulated in the clauses 1.1.3.2 to 1.1.3.3 above, shall not be considered for further evaluation and therefore rejected. The mere fact that the tenderer is qualified as mentioned in sub clauses 1.1.3.2 to 1.1.3.3 shall not imply that his bid shall automatically be accepted. The same should contain all technical data as required for consideration of tender prescribed in the ITT.
